For You (the Petitioner):

- Proof of U.S. citizenship (birth certificate or naturalization certificate)
- Copy of valid passport
- Marriage license or divorce decree from any previous marriages
- Two (2) passport photos (2x2 inches)

For Your Fiancé(e) (the Beneficiary):

- Copy of passport
- Birth certificate with certified English translation
- Divorce decrees or death certificates (from previous marriages)
- Two (2) passport photos (2x2 inches)
